Festival Regulations

These regulations are part of your contract with the Somerset Harp Folk Harp Festival.

- Sharing Booths. You may arrange to share a booth with one other exhibitor, with the consent of the Festival Director. The exhibitors whose names appear on this contract are the only entities allowed to exhibit in the booth assigned.
- Only those products/services listed on your contract are allowed in your booth and you may promote these only within the confines of your booth.
- Since we are not providing pipe & drape, you may bring your own backdrops. Unless the Festival director gives approval the sides of your exhibit extending beyond 5' from the curtain backdrop may not exceed 48 inches in height and no part of your exhibit may exceed 8 feet.
- Exhibits must be ready and staffed at the time the exhibit hall opens and be manned at all times or monitored by a neighboring vendor.
- Exhibitors and their staff must wear name badges at all times in the Festival area. These will be provided by the Festival.
- Festival director will assign all spaces and reserves the right to reassign spaces.
- All exhibits must have their name boldly displayed. You may use the sign we provide or your own. Festival management has the right to remove signs that are of poor quality.
- Acceptance of this contract by the Festival management is for the year 2010 only.
- Nothing edible or drinkable may be sold, dispensed, or given away without prior approval.
- All exhibits must be orderly and blend in with the folk harp theme of the Festival.
- There is absolutely NO SMOKING in any part of the Festival.
